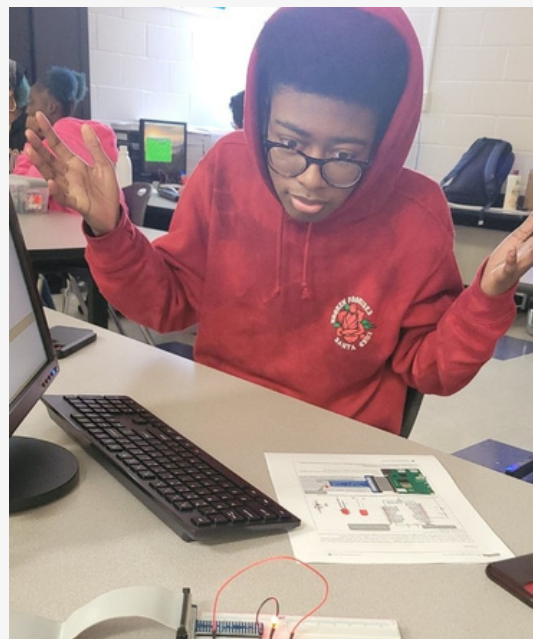
TECH TEAM
