Launched in 2025 in partnership with Google.org, NCBCE AI Fellows will generate a network of high-quality, innovative NC educators to serve as artificial intelligence (AI) leaders and mentors in their school communities.

This train-the-trainer model will create expanded learning opportunities for teachers and students throughout the state, sparking enhanced interest and engagement with ethical AI practices, and preparing students with the critical thinking and AI literacy skills essential for today's careers.

Following an application submission and virtual interview, 20 middle and high school educators will be selected each grant year.

Applicants may teach in any subject area and have any level of Al experience.

#### STATEWIDE IMPACT

The NCBCE AI Fellows program is poised to **empower** more than **1,000 educators** and enhance learning for **20,000+ students** statewide.
